HANOVER-HORTON SCHOOL DISTRICT SINKING FUND MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

This proposal will renew and allow the school district to continue to levy the building and site sinking fund millage that will expire with the 2026 tax levy.

Shall the currently authorized millage rate of 0.9576 mill (\$0.9576 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) which may be assessed against all property in Hanover-Horton School District, Jackson and Hillsdale Counties, Michigan, be renewed for a period of 8 years, 2027 to 2034, inclusive, to continue to provide for a sinking fund for the purchase of real estate for sites for, and the construction or repair of, school buildings, for school security improvements, for the acquisition or upgrading of technology, and for all other purposes authorized by law; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2027 is approximately \$409,000 (this is a renewal of millage that will expire with the 2026 tax levy)?

PROPOSAL TO ADOPT A NEW MILLAGE FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND IMPROVEMENT OF ROADS AND BRIDGES WITHIN WRIGHT TOWNSHIP

Shall the Township of Wright be authorized to levy up to 1.925 mills (\$1.93 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value) for a period of (20) twenty years, 2025 through 2044 inclusive, for the purpose of maintaining and improving roads and bridges within the Township; and shall the Township levy such millage for this purpose during such period, which will raise an estimated \$125,771 in the first year?
